



Main deck al fresco saloon

Sundeck



Upper observation deck




Master bedroom

VIP guest cabin





The full-beam VIP guest cabin features the finest of amenities, befitting your guests of honor.

A total five guest suites for luxury double accommodation are available. Two smaller suites feature large single beds. Additional Pullman beds are also available.






Engine room

Computer systems are separated from the main engine room. Large windows allow constant monitoring.



The engine room is designed for efficiency and easy access to mechanical systems for daily upkeep and maintenance. At the heart are two Caterpillar 3516C Diesel engines with a combine output of 5,000 kW and three Caterpillar C 18 generators.


Luxury yachting 360°

All yours


